**Abstract title: Policy for a Green Industrial Revolution on the Path to Net Zero**

Large-scale public investments in green infrastructure, housing and jobs play a crucial role in getting to net zero by 2050. Sometimes known as “Green New Deal” or “Green Industrial Revolution” policies, these innovative policy approaches can help to deliver a just transition away from polluting industries, while supporting workers and communities. Synergies particularly exist between green jobs, youth employment, and gender. This presentation will discuss challenges and opportunities for innovative green industrial policy using examples from the UK, EU, US, and Republic of Korea.
